Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who apply a broad range of competencies in a varied work context in the music industry, using some discretion and judgement and theoretical knowledge. They may provide support to a team.

This program is a performance program and includes areas of study in which students must learn an instrument and perform on that instrument with others and by themselves.

AIMS

The aim of this course is to provide participants with the knowledge and skills to achieve competencies that will enhance employment prospects in the Music Industry.

The course enables participants to gain a recognised credential and to make a more informed choice of vocation or career path.

ENROLMENT

Students are required to undertake a successful audition prior to enrolment in first year. Students enrolling in the second year of the Certificate III in Music are required to have successfully completed the first year.

PATHWAYS

This program has pathways into Certificate IV in Music, University and TAFE courses in Music and Audio Engineering.

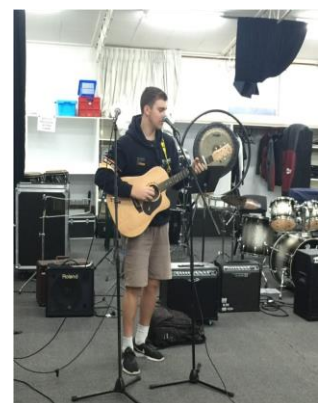
Second Year Band
