Course Overview

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge for an individual to be competent in performing core skills in outdoor recreation environments and assisting with the conduct of a range of outdoor activities.

Work may be undertaken as part of a team and would be performed under supervision. Work would be undertaken in field locations such as camps or in indoor recreation centres or facilities, in differing environments such as water-based, dry land and mountainous terrains, using a diverse range of equipment.

AIMS

The aim of this course is to provide participants with the knowledge and skills to achieve competencies that will enhance employment prospects in the Outdoor Recreation Industry.

The course enables participants to gain a recognised credential and to make a more informed choice of vocation or career path.

ENROLMENT

There are no entry requirements for this qualification. Due to the high demand for this Certificate, numbers may be capped.

PATHWAYS

The course provides pathways into further qualifications in Outdoor Recreation and into Certificate III in Sport and Recreation. It is suitable for an Australian Apprenticeship pathway.
