Description:

This qualification is for students wishing to enter the personal services industry providing beauty treatments and services. The role of a beautician is to provide a range of beauty services including spray tanning, eyelash extensions, lash and brow treatments, and basic make-up services. Students will learn about working as part of a team and independently, using initiative and discretion where required, building a client base, and advising clients about attaining the best possible outcome from each service.

Pathways:

Possible job opportunities as a trainee in the beauty industry, sales consultant or merchandiser, or onto further study in the beauty therapy industry (Certificate III, IV, diploma of beauty therapy).
