APPRENTICESHIPS AND TRAINEESHIPS

CAREER PATHWAY



STEP 1

SCHOOL

School refers student to Head Start coordinator

STEP 2

INTERVIEW

Student has one on one meeting with Head Start coordinator to assess suitability

STEP 3

PRE WORK

Head Start coordinator assesses students readiness & identifies a individual personalised plan

Head Start coordinator makes parent contact

Head Start coordinator helps facilitate SWL, WE, work trial or SBAT

STEP 4

WORK TRIAL

SWL/WE takes place overseen by Head Start coordinator (maximum of 20 days)



STEP 5

CONCLUSION

Student found to be suitable for SBAT by employer



STEP 6

CONTRACT

Head Start pathway plan and training contact completed by all parties

STEP 7

WORK

Student begins Head Start Program and attends School, Work and Tafe as per individual Head Start pathway plan.



Head Start coordinator supports student and employer through to completion of apprenticeship or traineeship
