COURSE OVERVIEW:

CUA30920 Certificate III in Music (Sound Production) is offered to students under the auspices of the College of Sound and Music Production (RTO #41549). This qualification is for students who have an interest in music and sound production and are keen to develop skills in a range of areas such as recording, mixing and sound editing. Geelong High school has developed incredible facilities to facilitate this program including a dedicated recording studio and music production lab.

Sound Production Specialisation provides students with the practical skills and knowledge to record, mix and edit sound sources, and operate sound reinforcement equipment for live music events. The program includes core units such as implementing copyright arrangements, performing basic sound editing and developing music industry knowledge. Elective units provide students with the opportunity to learn the essentials of audio engineering and electronic music production. Students will gain competencies that will enhance their employment opportunities within the music industry, and a recognised qualification that will assist them in making a more informed choice when considering vocational and career pathways. Student do NOT need to be competent in an instrument to complete this course.



ENROLMENT:

Students are required to submit a VET application form which includes short written responses detailing their experience and goals in the field of Music and Sound Production. Students enrolling in the second year of the Certificate III in Music are required to have successfully completed the first year.

This study score can contribute directly to the primary four or as a fifth or sixth study.
